Important Information

Arrival: Check-in will be held 4:00-5:00 PM on the start day of each session at the Welcome Center. Please do your best to arrive during this time frame.

Departure: All sessions end on a Friday. Campers must be picked up between 9:00-10:00 AM on the final day of their session by a Designated Guardian.

Sign-Out: If your child must temporarily leave our premises, you will need to notify staff at least 30 minutes prior to pick up. Campers may be returned to the premises between 8:00 AM and 9:15 PM. Upon returning, they will need to be signed back in before rejoining activities and friends.

Phones: Campers will not need phones during their stay. For emergencies and concerns, you can reach camp staff at (573) 292-0116. Misuse of Phones and Electronics will result in confiscation. Devices will be returned directly to guardians during pick up on the final day of the session.

Loss and Damage: We are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal property. If this is a concern for an item, that item should be left in the safety of your home.
